

These noncompliant trailers must then exit the Paddock and park in an area designated by IMSA, likely outside the track itself, until the conclusion of the Event, when the trailers may re-enter the Paddock or adjacent area to load, no earlier than 30 minutes after the respective Race checkered flag. Teams with noncompliant trailers must contact their respective

IMSA Series Manager and IMSA Logistics to declare their intent in advance of staging.
